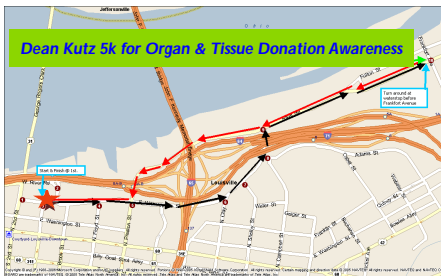


## Course Description

The Waterfront course takes you through the heart of the city as you run along the Ohio River and through Louisville's unique Waterfront Park. The 5k begins at 1st and Witherspoon St. and continues east onto River Road. Runners will loop around at Frankfort Avenue and continue back westward along River Road until connecting with Witherspoon near the finish line. This course will cater to all levels of runners and provide both enjoyment and competition alike.
