OFFICIAL RULES

HOW TO FORM A TEAM

- Any amateur golfer, male or female, is eligible to compete in the National Kidney Foundation Golf Classic.
- Every team competing in the National Kidney Foundation Golf Classic must consist of four amateur golfers whose USGA Handicap Indexes total 42.0 or more.
- Only one golfer on each team may have a USGA Handicap Index of 8.0 or less.
- Golfers' handicaps are effective as of the latter of: (1) the day of registration for the tournament (i.e., the day the entire fee is paid) or (2) the day sixty days prior to the tournament.
- Any golfer wishing to participate who does not have a USGA Handicap Index will be required to provide scorecards attested to by a PGA Professional from which a "National Kidney Foundation Golf Classic Handicap" will be calculated in accordance with USGA Rules.
- Each golfer who has a USGA Handicap Index will be required to present a current copy of his or her handicap card to the tournament committee at the time of registration. Only verified USGA handicapped teams will be eligible to advance to the finals at Pebble Beach Golf Resorts.
- All golfers will be required to present a photo ID on the day of the tournament.
- Any team that contains a member who does not comply with each of these requirements will not be eligible to win prizes or qualify to be invited to the National finals.
- The National Kidney Foundation has the right to deny the entry of any players or teams.
- Every player's drive must be used three times during the round.

TEAM USGA HANDICAP INDEX

All handicap disputes shall be settled by arbitration with the USGA (or governing state golf association) in accordance with USGA Rules, and the decision rendered by the arbitrator may be entered in any court having jurisdiction thereof. Any golfer who is found to have misrepresented his/her USGA Handicap Index shall be disqualified. The National Kidney Foundation Golf Classic reserves the right to report flagrant infractions to the golfer's state golf association and the USGA. The National Kidney Foundation Golf Classic Committee decisions are final and not subject to appeal. This rule does not prevent a Committee from correcting an incorrect ruling and imposing or rescinding a penalty.
